"The biggest concern for local people is the amount of litter. At a Hastings Council Meeting, I asked about regular street cleaning and was told it can be up to every six weeks. I don't think that's good enough!"

Green Jo organised a Litter Pick in Victoria Avenue last month. With the help of some volunteers, Jo collected three bags of rubbish. She also reported some potholes, overgrown hedges. broken kerb stones and a blocked drain. They were also joined by some young volunteers, aged six and three. Jo adds,

"There'll be more Litter Picking events coming soon. If there is an area round here that needs some TLC, let me know."

Cancelled buses, potholes and overgrown hedges!



Thankfully after some repairs the buses are now running again. Jo said, "I am committed to active travel and know how important regular buses are for people. I will do everything I can to campaign for better and more reliable buses. I will be checking that East Sussex County Council (ESCC) keep the roads in good repair so no future buses are cancelled."

Many residents are also concerned about the closed pavement in Victoria Avenue. After speaking with ESCC Jo has been assured that work on the hole and the hedges will take place next month.
