Active Green Cllr Jo Walker brought a motion to Hastings Borough Council to support the Plastic Free Communities campaign, which encourages residents, businesses to reduce single-use plastic in Hastings. Cllr Jo Walker will be part of the Steering Group that will guide Hastings towards gaining Plastic Free Status. Jo explains, "This isn't about removing plastic altogether, but rather encouraging us all to think about alternatives, reduce our reliance on single-use plastics, and help others make similar changes."

Jo says "Reducing single-use plastic in Hastings will have a positive impact on our environment. Plus, businesses that participate in the campaign can earn an award for their efforts. Achieving Plastic Free Status will also boost Hastings' reputation as an eco-conscious tourist destination."

There will be a beach clean on 7th March, 10am from the pier, plus a Big Ore Spring Community Clean on Sunday 27th April, 10am from the Ore Community Centre.


YOUR GREEN-LED COUNCIL: OUR WORK SO FAR


